

- 4. The population of South Africa is approximately 58 million. About 40 million people are over 18 years of age. South Africa is aiming to vaccinate about 67% of the population. That is approximately 40 million people.
- There are numerous active public and non-public, as well as private, vaccine sites and as of 26 July 2021, public and private health sites, faith organisations, and pharmacies in South Africa are administering vaccines: https://sacoronavirus.co.za/active-vaccination-sites/:
 - The EVDS registration system will now allow walk-in registrations and vaccination, SMS, WhatsApp and telephonic (call centre) registrations, and self- scheduling 'appointments'.
 - As of 24 July 2021, South Africa is vaccinating anyone over 35 years
 of age including documented non-nationals living in South Africa –
 though undocumented people are currently excluded from the roll out.
 There are obstacles faced by non-nationals, poorer communities, noninsured, and elderly people without free transport, especially in several
 non-urban and hard to reach areas, even with mobile vaccine clinics
 and home vaccinations available in some parts of the country.
- Adults living with a comorbidity are not yet specifically identified for registration, but all people over 35 years are now eligible for vaccination (from 15 July) and from September all over 18-year-olds.
