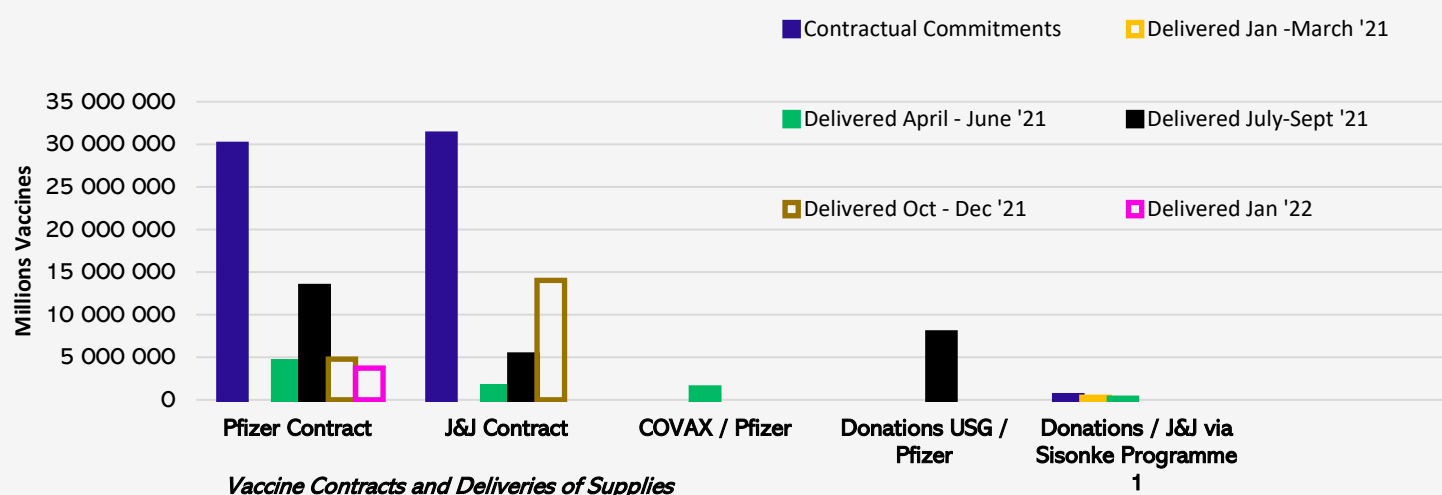

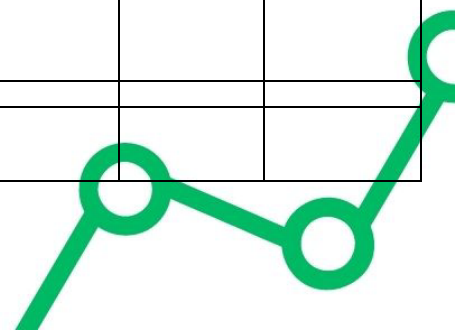

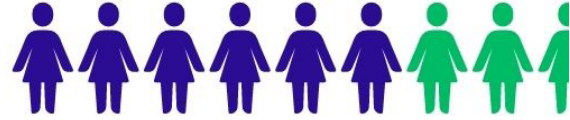

South Africa has procured, and secured options for the future procurement, of millions of doses of vaccines – through direct purchase agreements with vaccine manufacturers or their licensees; through the Covax Facility and by way of donations.

As of 13 February 2022, 30 559 431 vaccines have been administered in South Africa.

As of 13 February 2022, approximately 56 883 080 vaccines have been delivered to South Africa. There is a concern therefore that some of the already delivered vaccines could expire shortly, unless used or diverted.

Vaccines have been procured at great cost: the 2021 National Budget alone allocated an amount of R10-billion for the purchase of Covid-19 vaccines. The contracts (terms and conditions) remain a secret.

- 1/3 of deliveries on the J&J contract (approx. 10 million) is outstanding, and government, through the Department of Health should advise the next steps, and the terms applicable to its use or non-use.
- 1.8 million vaccines from Pfizer's total contract are outstanding and likely to be delivered in Q1 '22. Government, through the Department of Health should advise whether additional Pfizer vaccines will be procured, given recent age and booster approvals and policy decisions.

- Delivery dashboards and Vaccine Manufacturers Contracts are still not publicly available.*
- The Fill and Finish License Agreements for Aspen (J&J) and Biovac (Pfizer) are not publicly available.*
- All information is based on sources that are publicly available or shared with the Health Justice Initiative (HJI) and HJI is not responsible for the results obtained from your use or reliance on this information. The information is at times imperfect due to the lack of proper information sharing by relevant stakeholders.*
